VACCINATE OR REGULAR TESTING (VORT) FOR JP STAFF AND PORT USERS

This circular will supersede JP Circular 69 of 2021.

In line with the National transition from pandemic to endemic phase of COVID-19, Jurong Port will be implementing the policy of Vaccinate or Regular Testing (VoRT) port wide for all front line staff.

In view of the risk profile of Jurong Port's operation pertaining to COVID-19, frequent testing is still essential for all front-line staff to detect and ringfence infections as early as possible. Please see the summary table on the latest changes in red, detailing the various testing frequencies with regards to vaccination status for both Zone 1 and 2 operators which will be in effect from 1 October 2021. Please refer to Annex A for details.

We would also like to remind port users that all existing Government subsidies for the various costs incurred during the mandatory swab tests (PCR and ART) will cease on 31 Dec 2021. All companies are required to plan and factor this as part of your operational budget from year 2022 onwards.

The Multi-Ministerial Task Force will be offering each company 8 sets of self-test kits per employee for weekly testing over a period of 2 months. The testing can be administered by the individual at home or at the work place but employers must put in place a process where the tests are done properly and reported to the relevant Govt Agencies. Kindly refer to the attachment in the table below for details on the uploading of test results. All companies are encouraged to commence transition into the Employer-led Supervised Self-swab (ESSS). Government subsidies are available till 31 Dec 2021 and cover the ESSS training and ESSS ART kits.

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Together, we can all do our part to ensure that our workplace is safe and secure for the continuation of business operations.

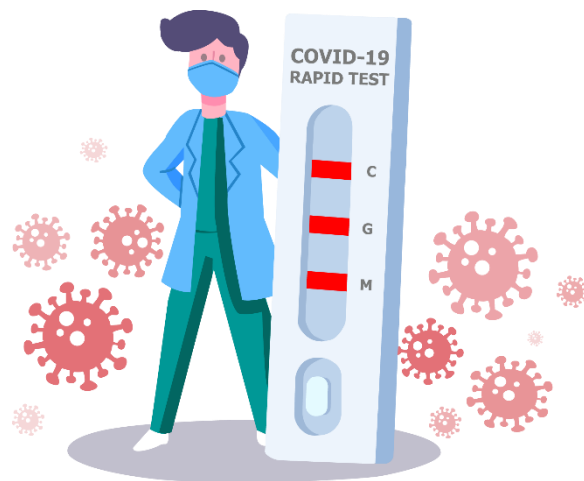

1 Introduction

This document is a guide to provide details on how

- a. Company Admins are able to update the excel file for Supervised Self-Administered Antigen Rapid Testing (ART) and upload the completed excel file to Swab Registration System (SRS),
- b. Sector leads can download reports for Self-administered ART attendance and results

2 Update Excel file

The excel templates for update are downloadable from SRS.

There are 2 different excel templates for capturing of the ART results. In this section, you will be guided on how to update the excel file for:

- a. Supervised Self-Administered ART via UEN; and
- b. Supervised Self-Administered ART (without UEN)

NB: Supervisors are to validate the identities and correctness of the individual's data input into SRS

2.1 Supervised Self-Administered ART via UEN

This option is intended for individual records who are in SRS as SRS will extract the required data from its database to minimise the data required to be captured by the Supervisors.

This mode of SRS will perform validation of these records during upload of the results and if the individual cannot be found under the UEN's employee records, SRS will display an error. To resolve this error, the Company HR of that UEN will need to add the individual's records into their employee records. If this is not possible, then Supervisor should the excel template in section 2.2.

For submission of ART results for individuals, the Supervisor can update the details accordingly to the excel file as indicated in Figure 1, shown below.

2.2 Supervised Self-Administered ART (without UEN)

This option is meant for individual records not in SRS, e.g. transient workers like lorry truck drivers. The Supervisor can update the details accordingly to the excel file as indicated in Table 2, shown below.

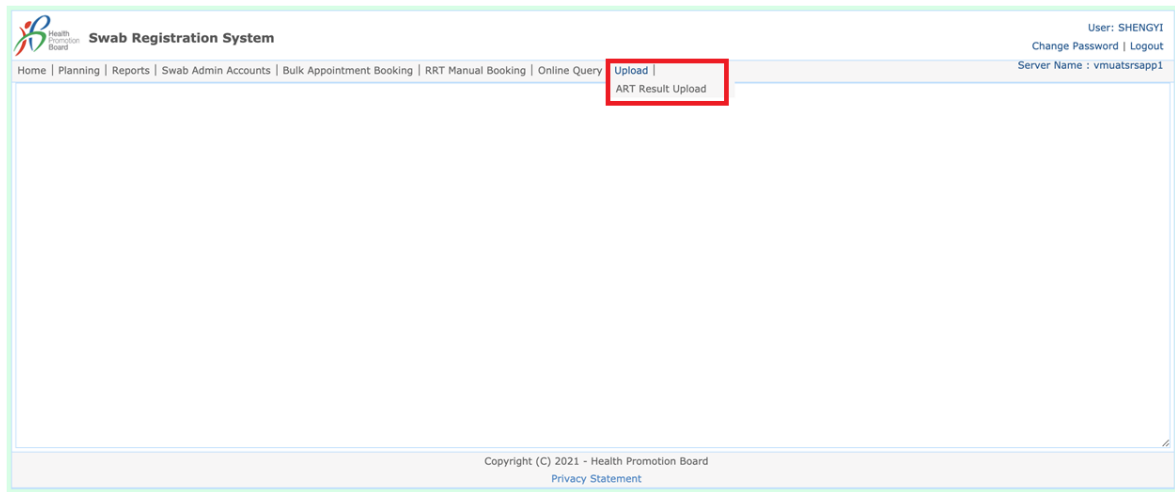

3 Uploading of Excel file

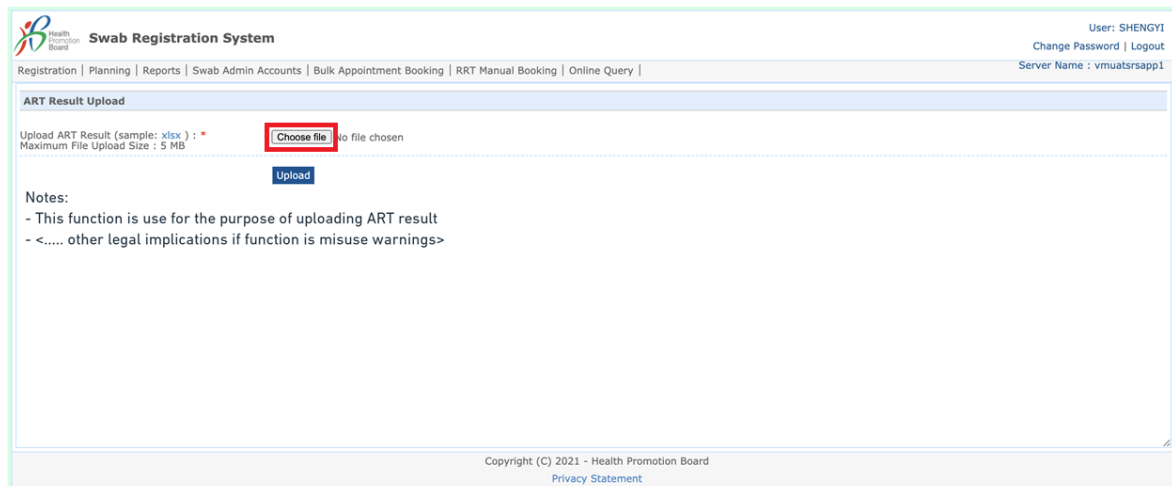
In this section, you will be guided on how to upload the excel file into SRS system. SRS will perform 2 types of validation:

- a. Validation on field level for the excel
- b. Validation against SRS database (ie checking if individuals are found in the specified UEN, or if the results in the excel sheet have been duplicated etc)

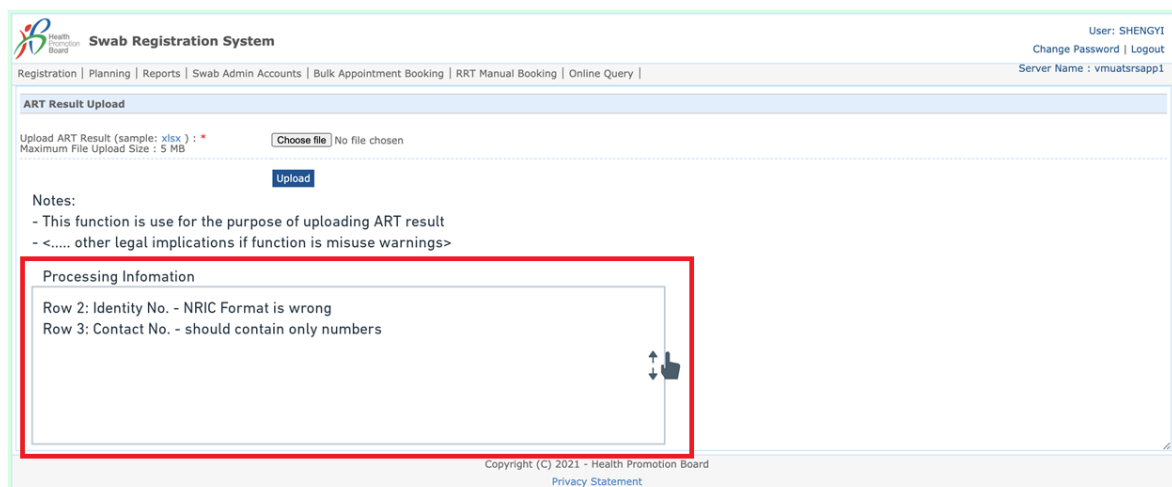
3.1 Login to SRS and click on Upload link followed by ART Result Upload.




3.2 Click on [Choose File] button and select the excel file to upload.



Companies could prepare a nominal roll of staff envisages to take the ART tests in advance to minimise the amount of data entry on site.

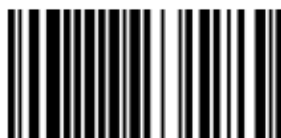
4.2 Usage of barcodes and barcode scanners
