## **AMENDMENT OF FET RRT REQUIREMENTS FOR TIER 1 & 2 PERSONNEL**

This Circular will supersede the following:

- a. JP Circular No. 102 of 2021 dated 21 December 2021

Reference:

- a. JP Circular No. 98 of 2021 dated 6 December 2021
- b. JP Circular No. 99 of 2021 dated 7 December 2021

Dear All,

1. This circular is to be read in conjunction with the references above.
2. With effect from 14 January 2022, the amended requirements to JP Circular No. 99 of 2021 are as follows (please see Annex A):
  - a. All Tier 1 personnel who are tested Ag+ will no longer be required to undergo a confirmatory PCR test at a Combined Test Centre (CTC). Ag+ personnel will need to follow Protocols 1-2-3.
  - b. All Tier 2 fully vaccinated recovered personnel will:
    - i. be exempted from FET RRT if within 270 days from date of Covid-19 infection.
    - ii. have to undergo a 7D FET RRT if more than 270 days from the date of Covid-19 infection.
4. Together, we can all do our part to ensure that our workplace is safe and secure for the continuation of business operations.

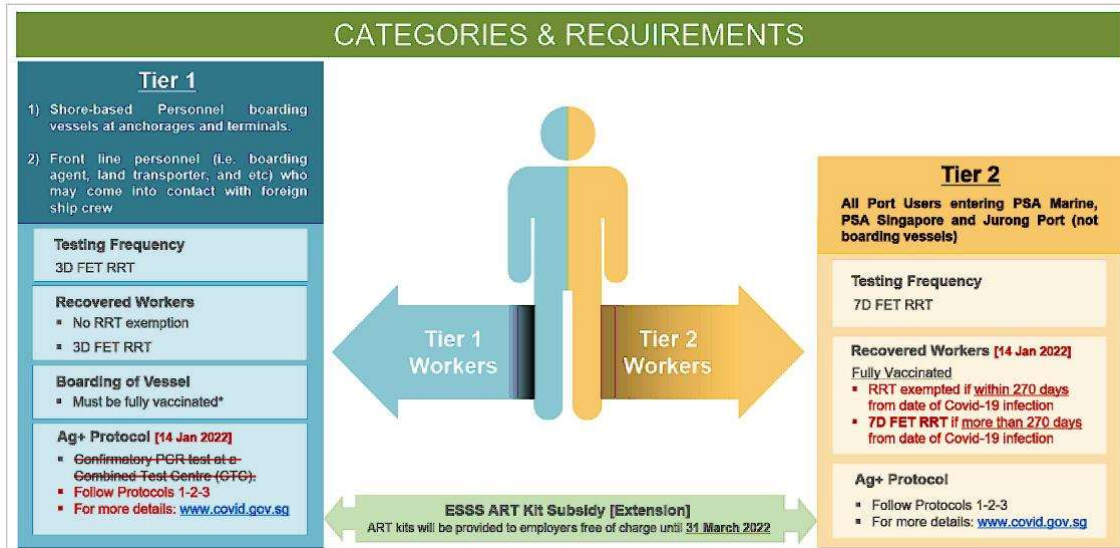

\*An individual is considered fully vaccinated if he/she:

- a) Has received the appropriate regimen of World Health Organisation Emergency Listing (WHO EUL) vaccines including their respective duration post-vaccination for the vaccine to be fully effective and had their vaccination records ingested in MOH's national IT systems,
- b) Is recovered from a COVID-19 infection and subsequently receives at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine (2 doses if Sinovac or Sinopharm) that has been authorized under the Health Sciences Authority's Pandemic Special Access Route or listed on the World Health Organisation's Emergency Use Listing (WHO EUL) no earlier than 3 months after date of positive PCR and
- c) Is fully vaccinated before being infected with COVID-19 and subsequently recovering from it.

Persons who received one dose of COVID-19 vaccine before being infected would need to receive their 2<sup>nd</sup> dose (3<sup>rd</sup> dose if Sinovac or Sinopharm) to be exempted.
